2016-2017 Gardner Refuse Collection

The City supplied 48 gallon toter for trash each week collected per household. Any extra trash must be in the City PAYT bags available at the following places: Stop & Shop and Hannaford Supermarkets, Agway, and Aubuchon Hardware Store.

- Free recycling of bottles, cans, milk cartons, juice boxes and plastic containers in the recycling toter.
- Free recycling of paper, paperboard and cardboard flattened and cut to fit within the toter.
- Free yard waste collection as per enclosed schedule, Christmas tree collection in January.
- You can obtain an additional recycling toter for \$2 per month, billed quarterly.

Remember You must put your toters out by 7:00 am on the day of collection and you must bring them in within 12 hours after collection.

Did you know...?

- Massachusetts prohibits the disposal of the following items:
- Paper and cardboard
 - Bottles and cans
 - Leaves and yard waste
 - Car batteries
 - TVs and computers
 - Large home appliances
- Be sure to keep these items out of your trash.

For all Residents with Municipal Trash Collection

Toter Do's & Don'ts

- Do place your toter out by 7am on the day of collection
- Do place your toter at the curb with the serial number facing the street
- Do leave 3 feet between your trash and recycling toters
- Do take your toter in within 12 hours after collection
- Don't Park in front of your toter or place it behind an obstacle- pole, mailbox etc.
- Don't put your toter out more than 24 hours in advance
- Don't overfill toter



EASY!

Single Stream Recycling is easy!
Place ALL recycling together in toter



- Newspaper with inserts
- Magazines, catalogs, paperbacks & phone books
- Junk mail & office paper
- Paper bags, paperboard, e.g. cereal box
- Corrugated cardboard, cut to 2'x2' max
- Glass bottles/jars (all colors)
- Tin, steel, aluminum food cans & lids, aluminum foil, empty aerosol cans
- Plastic containers labeled with recycling symbol
- Milk & juice cartons, drink boxes



- No plastic bags
- No Styrofoam
- No wet or soiled paper
- No cans containing hazardous material
- No light bulbs, window glass, auto glass, dishes, glasses, Pyrex
- No pizza boxes

Gardner's Medication and Sharps Collection

Remember that you can dispose of old or unused medications responsibly in the kiosks located in the lobby of the Gardner Police Department, 200 Main Street, Gardner. A Sharps Collection Kiosk is available to dispose of medical sharps in the entry stairway of Community Health Connections on the second floor of 175 Conners St. Sharps boxes are available in the Board of Health office in City Hall. The Montachusett Public Health Network has placed sharps and medication collection boxes in all member towns, and these are available for your use as well. Drop-Off Recycling, Yard Waste, Trash, Composting, and Construction Debris

The following items ARE NOT picked up curbside and may be brought to the recycling center on 744 West Street (Rt 68) between the hours of 9am to 3pm Wed thru Fri and 7am to 1pm on Saturdays. Acceptable items WITHOUT a cost include textiles including shoes, rags, worn, damaged or stained clothing. Used motor oil, anti-freeze, scrap metal, auto batteries, Ni-Cad rechargeable batteries, Lithium batteries, hearing aid and small "button" batteries and paint-see surplus paint brochure for additional information on paint.

Items WITH a cost include major appliances such as stoves, dryers, washers, dishwashers, small engines (mowers, etc.), refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, water bubblers, TV's, and monitors at \$15.00 ea.; upholstered furniture, mattresses, and boxsprings at \$15 ea.; wood furniture at \$10 ea.; fluorescent bulbs and propane tanks at \$2.00 ea.; and tires at \$5 ea. Trash and construction waste charged per load.

All charges must be paid in advance at the Health Department at City Hall. Stickers to use the Transfer Station can be obtained at City Hall.

Items below included at no charge with Transfer Station Sticker (obtained from City Hall)

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Day

Recycling Collection Schedule

Recycling toters are collected every other week on your regular trash collection day. All A Weeks are collected during weeks highlighted in BLUE on calendar (on other side). All B Weeks are collected during weeks highlighted in GREEN. Find your street on the street listing to see if you are A or B Week. Please place at curbside on your scheduled day.

Holiday Schedule and Weather Cancellation

Whenever there is a weather cancellation or a scheduled collection falls on a holiday, that day's collection and all remaining collections for the week will be delayed one day. Weather cancellations will be announced on the city web site, gardner-ma.gov, and on the trash hotline, **978-630-4023**. Holidays are marked.

Note – Monday Holidays do not Affect Trash, Recycling or Yard Waste Collection.

Yard Waste Collection



- Leaves, grass and all other easily raked material. Place in paper bags, open barrels or boxes.
- Branches less than 2" dia., not to exceed 3' long – bundled
- Yard waste collection: first full collection week (Tues-Friday) of July, Aug., Sept., Oct., Nov., April, May & June that does not contain a holiday. Christmas tree and yard waste pickup in Jan. Two yard waste collections in November!
