In accordance with Article X of the City of Gardner Zoning Code, Chapter 675-1010, Site Plan Review, notice is hereby given that the Gardner Planning Board will conduct a Public Review Meeting on Tuesday, June 8, 2021 at 6:45 p.m., **REMOTELY** * to consider the Definitive Site Plan application submitted by Jones Family Fredette Street, LLC, and Garlic Printing & Converting Corp. Due to the ongoing conditions related to the COVID 19 outbreak, the meeting will be held via Zoom.

The Definitive Plan depicts proposed construction of a new 15,035 s.f. warehousing and connector structure between two primary buildings located at 100 and 112 Fredette Street. The building will be primarily utilized as a warehousing structure as part of the expansion of the business on the property.
